Does your group have specific needs for a stay such as a teambuilding weekend, walking weekend or family reunion? We adapt ourselves to your wishes.



Orchimont: A rich past


Orchimont is a small village in the district of Vresse-sur-Semois in the province of Namur. About a hundred people still live there. The village is located two kilometers north of the center of Vresse and the stream "La Semois" near the French border. The hamlet Hérisson also belongs to Orchimont.

Orchimont (etymologically it means "Mountain of the Bears") had during the Middle Ages the status of city surrounded by ramparts and defended by a castle. In 1635, the army of Louis XIII invaded the Spanish Netherlands. On May 11, Orchimont fell and the castle was destroyed and never rebuilt. The construction of a road in 1878 destroyed even more the historical site. A renovated tower is the only thing remaining of the site.

Itinerary:

From Flanders via the E411 Namur - Arlon:

Exit 23, direction Wellin-Center. On the roundabout in Wellin Center, choose Gedinne-Station. In Gedinne-Station, take left before the railway crossing direction Bièvre. On the roundabout in Bièvre, take the first exit direction Town Center. After 400m, go left to Orchimont. The distance between Exit 23 and the hotel is about 34 km.
